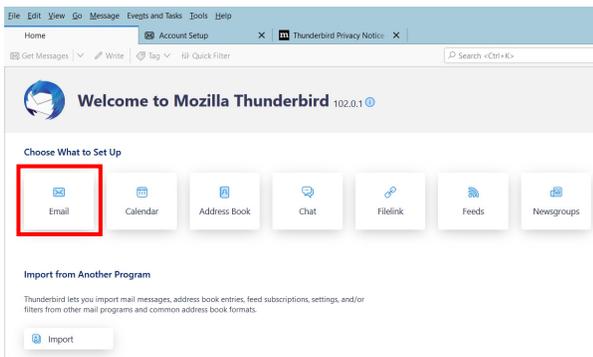


Getting Started

Add a New Thunderbird Email Account

1 Setting up Thunderbird for the first time:

- Open **Thunderbird**
- Click on the **Email** icon under “**Choose What to Set Up**”

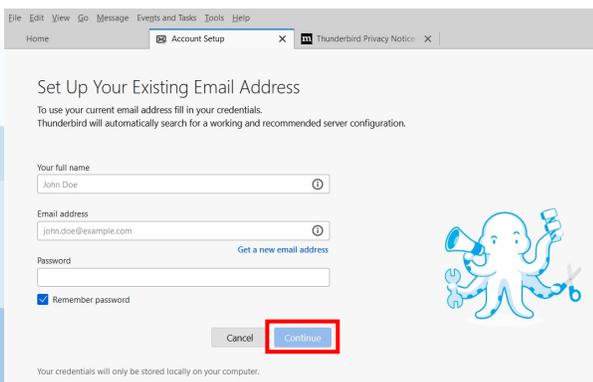


2 A window will open which will allow you to enter your existing HomeSC email information (ex: myemail@homesc.com).

- Home Telecom has already provided you with an email address. Be sure to enter your **full name, HomeSC email address, and your email password.**

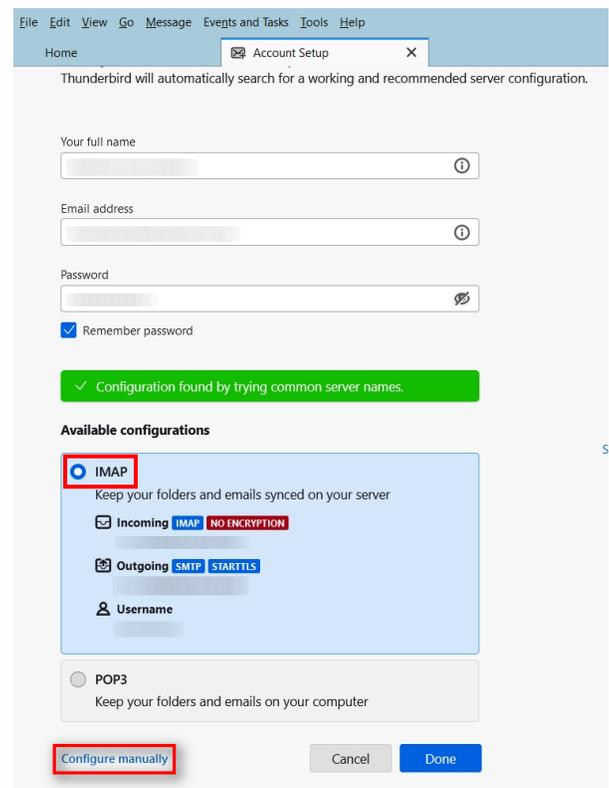
You may also choose to have Thunderbird save your email password by selecting the checkbox next to **Remember password.**

- Click **Continue**



3 The system will process your input to find your email configuration:

- Make sure that **IMAP** is selected (under Available configurations)
- Click the **Configure manually** link located at the bottom left of your window



Getting Started

Add a New Thunderbird Email Account (cont.)

- Update your Incoming and Outgoing Server Settings:
 - Make sure that the **Incoming Server Protocol** drop-down is set to **IMAP**
 - Edit the **Incoming Server Hostname** is set to: **mail.homesc.com**
 - Ensure that the **Incoming Server Port** is displaying **993**
 - Make sure that the **Incoming Server Connection Security** drop-down is set to **SSL/TLS**
 - Select the **Incoming Server Authentication Method** drop-down and choose **Normal password**
 - Edit the **Outgoing Server Hostname** to: **smtp.homesc.com**
 - Make sure that the **Outgoing Server Port** field is set to **465**
 - Make sure that the **Outgoing Server Connection Security** drop-down is set to **SSL/TSL**
 - Select the **Outgoing Server Authentication Method** drop-down and choose **Normal password**
 - Enter your **full email address** (ex: *myemail@homesc.com*) into both Username fields (Incoming and Outgoing)
 - Click **Done**
